A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND EXECUTION OF A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL CONSERVANCY

WHEREAS, in 1987 the City Council adopted the Southeastern San Diego

Community Plan to direct and guide future development in Southeastern San Diego, and

WHEREAS, Chollas Creek is a natural creek traversing Southeastern San Diego from

Lemon Grove and Mid-City to San Diego Bay, and

WHEREAS, the Southeastern San Diego Community Plan calls for Chollas Creek to be developed as a linear park from Lemon Grove and Mid-City to San Diego Bay, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has drafted the Chollas Creek Enhancement Program which calls for the planning and design of physical improvements to implement the City's General Plan/Community Plans, and

WHEREAS, the California Coastal Conservancy has expressed an interest in providing matching grant funding to the Chollas Creek Enhancement Program that would fund the planning, design and physical improvements to enhance the natural drainage areas that connect the creek to the California Coast, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply to the California Coastal Conservancy, for matching grant funding for the Chollas Creek Enhancement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute all documents, including applications, contracts, agreements, and amendments hereto, necessary to implement and carry out the purposes of the California Coastal Conservancy Matching Grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is authorized to accept and expend funds from the California Coastal Conservancy to carry out and administer the City obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the terms of Grant.
