WHEREAS, Mr. Norman T. Seltzer attended San Diego State University, University of California at Berkeley, and University of California, Hastings College of the Law, where he received his Juris Doctorate in 1942; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Seltzer served as a First Lieutenant, Navigator and Navigation Instructor in the United States Air Corps from 1942 to 1946; and

WHEREAS, in 1944, Mr. Seltzer was admitted to the California Bar Association and practiced law from 1946 to 1947 at Lindley, Higgins, Lazar, & Johnson; and

WHEREAS, he began working at Seltzer, Caplan, Wilkins, & McMahon in 1948, where he has served as President and Managing Partner from 1968 to 1997, Chairman of the Board of Directors Emeritus from 1998 to present, and Ombudsman from 1998 to present; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Seltzer is a member of the San Diego County Bar Association, American Bar Association, and the State Bar of California; and

WHEREAS, he has served as a member of The City of San Diego Park & Recreation Board, Board of Visitors at the University of San Diego School of Law, Board of Trustees at San Diego Community Foundation, Board of Directors at Mercy Hospital Foundation, City of San Diego Charter Revision Commission; and

WHEREAS, he was National Chair of University of California Hastings College of the Law 1994-1995 Annual Fund Campaign, Chairman of the Mercy Hospital Foundation, and in 1999 was appointed as Commissioner of the Civil Service Commission; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend Mr. Norman T. Seltzer for his years of service and dedication to The City of San Diego.
