WHEREAS, Dr. Morgan received her premedical and medical school training at the University of Santo Tomas in Manila, Philippines; her internship at McLaren General Hospital in Flint, Michigan and Pediatric Residency at Children's Hospital in Detroit, Michigan with immeasurable experience in local health centers, including the American Indian Health Center, Home Health Service, Linda Vista Health Care Center, and Comprehensive Health Center; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Morgan has given of her time and talents over the years and has successfully aided in the safe passage from adolescence to adulthood of countless youngsters

prior to her decision to retire from the University of California San Diego Medical Center; NOW,
