WHEREAS, Phases I and II of the Community Service Center Implementation Plan have been completed with the establishment of nine Community Service Centers in the areas of Rancho Bernardo, Otay Mesa/Nestor, Chollas View (now called Market Street), Mid-City, Clairemont, San Ysidro, Peninsula, Golden Hill, and Navajo; and

WHEREAS, in addition to providing information and services, the Community Service

Centers emphasize an integrated and coordinated approach to delivering services; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That Phase III of the Community Service Center Implementation Plan is hereby approved and that the City Manager is hereby authorized to proceed with establishing three new Community Service Centers in the following Community Service Center service areas:
- (1) Rancho Penasquitos/Scripps Ranch/Mira Mesa/Miramar; (2) North City/Torrey Pines/Carmel Valley/Sorrento Valley; and (3) North Park.
- 2. That the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, to negotiate and execute leases for the three new Community Service Centers, with the leases being drawn up in accordance with the City's general lease standards, subject to compliance with all applicable

City regulations, and at locations approved by the office of the City Council member for the Council District in which the Community Service Center is to be located.

3. That the City Manager is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed two hundred ninety-one thousand dollars (\$291,000.00), solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for implementation of Phase III of the Community Service Center Implementation Plan.
