

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-292152

ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 14, 1999


WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission [FCC] granted use of channel 3 frequency to a Mexican government-run television station XHTJB-TV; and

WHEREAS, many televisions use channel 3 for reception from an external tuner such as cable, satellite or VCR hookup, and the use of channel 3 may cause interference with all channels using an external tuner; and

WHEREAS, thousands of households in the United States report experiencing interruption of television reception potentially due to the use of channel 3 by station XHTJB-TV; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council calls upon the FCC to place a ceiling on the level of transmission output related to the use of channel 3 by station XHTJB-TV so as to limit interference with television reception in the United States.
