

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 292160

ADOPTED ON SEP 14 1999

APPROVING MAP OF 464 & 476 PROSPECT STREET - LA JOLLA

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds that certain map surveyed by Douglas C. Paul, Registered Civil Engineer, titled "464 & 476 PROSPECT STREET - LA JOLLA" [the MAP], being a subdivision of portions of lots 13, 33 and 48 and Lots 14 through 26 inclusive, and Lots 34 through 47 inclusive of La Jolla Park, in The City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 352, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, March 22, 1887, together with the northwesterly half of the alley lying within said Block 17 as vacated and closed to public use, adjacent to and adjoining said lots 13 through 26 inclusive, and Lots 33 through 48 together with all that portion of the southeasterly half of the alley lying within said Block 17 which is adjacent to and adjoining to said Lots 33 through 48 inclusive, is made in the manner and form prescribed by law and conforms to the surrounding surveys; that the MAP is in substantial conformance with the approved Tentative Map No.96-7888; that the MAP and the subdivision of land shown thereon is approved and accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds the sewer easement granted to The City of San Diego per Document recorded December 28, 1921 in Book 874, Page 108 of Deeds and a portion of that general utility easement granted to The City of San Diego per Document recorded June 22, 1993 as File No. 1993-0393413 of Official Records, are no longer needed for


the public purpose for which they were granted and are not shown within this MAP because they are abandoned pursuant to Section 66499.20 ½ of the State Subdivision Map Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council accepts on behalf of the City of San Diego, an easement for ingress and egress of emergency vehicles designated as "Emergency Access Easement Granted Hereon", as granted and shown on the MAP and subject to the conditions set forth on the MAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is authorized and directed to endorse upon the MAP, as and for the act of the Council, that the Council has approved the MAP and that the streets are accepted on behalf of the public as stated in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to transmit the MAP to the County Recorder of the County of San Diego, California, for recordation.
