WHEREAS, on March 18, 1997, by Resolution No. R-288456, the Council of The City of San Diego approved amendments to the Progress Guide and General Plan and the Carmel Valley Community Plan for the purpose of adopting revisions to the Plans related to implementation of the Multiple Species Conservation Program [MSCP]; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the California Coastal Commission modifications to the Carmel Valley Land Use Plan, North City Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan segment, and the Carmel Valley Neighborhood 8 Precise Plan was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the matter was heard by the Council on September 28, 1999; and
WHEREAS, on March 18, 1997, by Resolution No. R-288457, the Council certified
Environmental Impact Report LDR No. 93-0287, a copy of which is on file in the Planning and
Development Review Department; and

WHEREAS, in connection with consideration of the approval of California Coastal Commission modifications to the Carmel Valley Community Plan, North City Local Coastal Program, and the Carmel Valley Neighborhood 8 Precise Plan, the Council considered the issues discussed in Environmental Impact Report No. 93-0287; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the information contained in the final document, including any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Council and it is determined that no substantial

changes or new information of substantial importance within the meaning of CEQA

Guideline 15162 would warrant any additional environmental review in connection with approval of the above mentioned modifications.
