BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager is hereby directed to return to Council with a request for proposal for a consultant to provide a study, preferably within six months, that would look at the taxicab market in the City as follows:
 - (a) how many permits the City should have on the street;
 - (b) how the permits would be distributed;
 - (c) look at the issue of transferability; and
 - (d) look at what other cities are doing in this area.
- 2. That the City Manager is also directed to provide a more clear policy, and that taxicabs in outlying districts and the concept of an open market be part of the discussion.
- 3. That the City Attorney is directed to come back to Council with a recommendation on how the Council can look at the issue of transferability for existing medallions that are currently in use.
