

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-292257

ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 28, 1999

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is hereby directed to return to Council with a request for proposal for a consultant to provide a study, preferably within six months, that would look at the taxicab market in the City as follows:


- (a) how many permits the City should have on the street;
- (b) how the permits would be distributed;
- (c) look at the issue of transferability; and
- (d) look at what other cities are doing in this area.

2. That the City Manager is also directed to provide a more clear policy, and that taxicabs in outlying districts and the concept of an open market be part of the discussion.

3. That the City Attorney is directed to come back to Council with a recommendation on how the Council can look at the issue of transferability for existing medallions that are currently in use.
