

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 292306

ADOPTED ON OCT 18 1999

WHEREAS, for the third year, the San Diego-Tijuana Border Initiative will hold a day long conference in Tijuana to discuss children's issues as part of a long-term process to promote closer coordination and collaboration among social service agencies in Tijuana and San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the objective is to gather concerned groups and individuals from the San Diego-Tijuana border region to share experiences, review existing programs, discuss best practices and develop specific recommendations for future cross-border collaboration on children's issues and children's rights; and

WHEREAS, this group was launched in 1995 to organize binational workshops and it received endorsements from non-profit agencies on both sides of the U.S.-Mexico border and this year the objective is to educate leaders from different organizations on children's issues; and

WHEREAS, the topics for discussion include, culture and recreation, children at risk, education, family, health, legal issues; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it does hereby recognize the San Diego-Tijuana Border Initiative for their advocacy in community relations both nationally and internationally, and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims September 30, 1999, to be "**Binational Workshop on Children Day**" in The City of San Diego.
