

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 292415

ADOPTED ON NOV 0 8 1999

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation [CDPR] Habitat Conservation Fund Grant Program [Program] was created under the California Wildlife Protection Act of 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Program requires a fifty percent non-State funding match and provides two million dollars in competitive grants annually to public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the CDPR will select projects for funding which will be presented to the State Legislature and included in the FY 2001 State budget, with funding available in October of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City's Park and Recreation Department has identified the Black Mountain Park Miner's Ridge Trail Restoration [Project] as a competitive project under the Program guidelines; and


WHEREAS, the Project will consist of 1) the installation of approximately 1,500 linear feet of split rail fencing along the trail head to eliminate illegal off-road vehicle access, which has negatively impacted the existing foot trails and surrounding canyon habitat; and 2) will provide for general trail enhancement along the two-mile trail; and

WHEREAS, if the Program grant is secured, the City will receive \$20,100 and the required matching funds will be provided by in-kind ranger and volunteer work; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his duly designated representative is authorized to apply to the CDPR Program for the Project.
2. That the City Manager or his duly designated representative is authorized to take all necessary actions, including negotiating and executing all necessary agreements, to secure funding from the CDPR Program for the Project.
3. That the City Manager or his duly designated representative is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend funds if a Program grant is secured.
4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the Program grant.
