AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 24.1201 ALL RELATING TO THE SAN DIEGO CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Sec. 24.1201 Eligible Retirees

(c) Effective December 31, 1998, a third post retirement health benefit shall be offered to the spouses and dependents (under the age of 21) of a City employee Member killed in the line of duty by external violence or physical force, or as a result of an accident or injury caused by external violence or physical force and suffered in the line of duty. ~~For Safety Members, this benefit shall be paid if death benefits are payable under a final decision made pursuant to the federal Public Safety Officers Benefits Act to a spouse or dependents (under the age of 21). The surviving spouse and dependents (under the age of 21), shall be entitled to receive post retirement health benefits, in an amount equivalent to the annual Flexible Benefits Allotment as defined in the Annual Salary Ordinance adopted by the City Council, as Health Eligible Retirees as set forth in Division 12, Post Retirement Health Benefits. No benefits shall be provided under this section if :~~

(1) the death or injury resulting in death was caused by the intentional misconduct

of the employee or by the employee's intention to bring about his or her death or injury; (2) the employee was voluntarily intoxicated at the time of his or her death; (3) the employee was performing his or her duties in a grossly negligent manner at the time of death or injury; or (4) to any individual who would otherwise be entitled to a benefit under this section if such individuals actions were a substantial contributing factor to the death or catastrophic injury of the employee.
