AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 7 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 67.45 RELATING TO REGULATION OF ACTIVITY ON WATER DEPARTMENT PROPERTY

WHEREAS The City of San Diego Water Department desires to establish late night curfews at the Hodges, Sutherland, San Vicente, El Capitan, Lower and Upper Otay, and Barrett reservoirs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding a new Section 67.45 to read as follows:

Sec 67.45 Water Impounding System — Regulations for Recreational Activity Areas — Trespassing

- (a) All persons entering the properties of the water impounding system of The City of San Diego are subject to the rules and regulations of the Water Department, including sanitary regulations for the protection of the water supply. Violation of the Water Department's rules and regulations may result in revocation of a recreational permit, ejection from the premises, or both.
- (b) Except as provided in Section 67.45(c), it is unlawful for any person to enter or remain upon Water Department property as follows:
- (1) At Lake Hodges, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. The boundaries of the Water Department property at Lake Hodges are shown on the map on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. <u>OO1 8808-1</u>.

- (2) At the Barrett, El Capitan, Lower and Upper Otay, San Vicente, and Sutherland Reservoirs, at any time, except when the property is posted as open to the public. The boundaries of the Water Department property at Barrett, El Capitan, Lower and Upper Otay, San Vicente, and Sutherland Reservoirs are shown on the maps on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. 2.3,456
  - (c) Exceptions. Section 67.45(b) does not apply to the following persons:
- (1) Employees of governmental agencies while engaged in the performance of official duties.
  - (2) Persons who have been given written permission by the City Manager.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
