

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 10849

(O-2001-12)

ADOPTED ON SEP 18 2000

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CLASS I SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FRANCHISES TO SPECIFIED COMPANIES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS WITH THOSE COMPANIES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the following existing franchised haulers and subsidiaries are granted a Class I or Class II Franchise:


