

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18860 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON OCT 02 2000

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INCORPORATING VARIOUS PROPERTIES SURROUNDING LINDBERGH FIELD AS SHOWN IN ZONE MAP DRAWING NO. C-885, VERSION A, WITHIN THE GOLDEN HILL, MISSION BEACH, SOUTHEAST, PENINSULA, MIDWAY/PACIFIC HIGHWAY CORRIDOR, OCEAN BEACH, AND UPTOWN COMMUNITY PLAN AREAS, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO THE AIRPORT ENVIRONS OVERLAY ZONE, AS DEFENED BY SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 132.0301, 132.0302, 132.0303, 132.0306, 132.0307, 132.0308, 132.0309, AND 132.0310.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the various properties surrounding Lindbergh Field, in the Golden Hill, Mission Beach, Southeast, Peninsula, Midway/Pacific Highway Corridor, Ocean Beach, and Uptown Community Planning Areas, in the City of San Diego, California, as shown on Zone Map Drawing No. C-885, Version A, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.


OO- 18860, are incorporated into the Airport Environs Overiaiy Zone as that zone is described and defined by San Diego Municipal Code Chapter 13, Article 2, Division 3.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this

ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance. However, this ordinance will not apply within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified by the California Coastal Commission, or is certified with suggested modifications, this ordinance shall be void within the Coastal Zone.
