ADOPTED ON JAN 18 2000

WHEREAS, Maude Warring Kennedy was born to Eugene Cordell Warring and Carrie Williams Warring on January 4, 1900 in Wethersfield, Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, her early years were spent living with her family in a home in the Cove area of Wethersfield on the Connecticut River where her father was a commercial fisherman; and

WHEREAS, in 1912, the Warring family moved to Hartford, Connecticut where Maude attended public schools and graduated from Hartford Public High School; and

WHEREAS, she was a member of Tempos Proposito, a women's charity organization and attended the Union Baptist Church of Hartford, which was established in 1871 in a railroad box car and her parents were early members; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1927, Maude married Charles Leonard Kennedy and she and her husband were active members of the Dixwell Avenue Congregational Church; and


WHEREAS, Maude was a foster mother to a number of children, while raising her son, two nephews, and two daughters; and

WHEREAS, she moved to San Diego in 1977 and resided at the Lakeshore Villa Apartments until 1997, when she moved to her daughter's home in Del Cerro; and

WHEREAS, Maude is retired from Yale University, a member of the Southeastern Community Church, a founding member of The Girls of San Diego, a supportive member of Las Munecas Auxiliary of the Children's Home Society; NOW, THEREFORE,
