WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department [IRD] for the City of San Diego is charged with reviewing state ballot propositions to determine possible effects on the City; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1999, IRD recommended to the Council's Committee on Rules, Finance, and Intergovernmental Relations [Rules Committee] in its Report No. 99-12 that this City officially support state Propositions 12, 13, and 14 on the March 2000 ballot; and,

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1999, the Rules Committee by 4-0 vote approved IRD's recommendations; and,

WHEREAS, for the reasons set forth in IRD Report NO. 99-12, the City Council desires to support Propositions 12, 13, and 14; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego that this City officially supports the passage of Propositions 12, 13, and 14 on the March 2000 ballot.
