BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims the month of March 2000 to be "Census"

**Awareness Month"** in San Diego and encourages every San Diegan to complete and mail back their Census survey forms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council supports the United States Census

Bureau's effort to count every resident of the City, without regard to citizenship status or legal
residency, and applauds the efforts of the Regional Complete Count Committee and City of San
Diego Complete Count Team.
