

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293001

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING APPLICATIONS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE-LOCAL-TRIBAL WETLAND GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS: (1) SAN PASQUAL/SANTA YSABEL MONITORING AND MANAGEMENT PLAN AND (2) VERNAL POOL PRESERVATION GAP ANALYSIS.

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency [EPA] has implemented the State-Local-Tribal Wetland Grant Program [Grant Program] which provides grant funding to local governments for the monitoring and managing of wetland resources; and

WHEREAS, the EPA has established the procedures and criteria for reviewing and awarding grant proposals; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, as a grant applicant, if selected, will enter into agreements with the EPA; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it authorizes the City Manager or his representative to apply to the EPA Grant Program for the following projects: (1) San Pasqual/Santa Ysabel Monitoring and Management Plan and (2) Vernal Pool Preservation Gap Analysis. Copies of the proposed applications are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. RR- 293001-1 and RR- 293001-2

2. That it certifies that the City understands the assurances and certifications in the grant applications.

3. That it authorizes the City Manager or his representative to take all necessary actions to secure funding from the EPA for the aforementioned projects.


4. That it authorizes the City Manager and City Attorney or their representatives to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.

5. That it authorizes the City Manager or his representative to accept, appropriate, and expend funds in accordance with the grants, if the grants are awarded.

6. That it hereby authorizes the Auditor and Comptroller to establish separate interest-bearing accounts, if the grants are awarded.
