

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293077

ADOPTED ON MAY 15 2000

WHEREAS, the members of San Diego Medical Services Enterprise, an innovative, public/private partnership between San Diego Fire & Life Safety Services and Rural/Metro Corporation, continue to provide high quality and carting EMS service to our citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by designating Emergency Medical Services Week;

WHEREAS, injury prevention and the appropriate use of EMS system will help reduce national healthcare costs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the week of May 14-20, 2000, is hereby proclaimed to be "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK" and the City Council encourages all residents to increase their knowledge and awareness of the EMS system and commends every member of the EMS team for their dedicated efforts in times of emergency.
