WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department desires to apply for, accept and expend a grant from the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereinafter referred to as OCJP); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, expend and administer funds for the above named grant application, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 293092;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant application, acceptance, operation, contracts, expenditures, and certifications that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this grant;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept, expend and administer any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding of this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by OCJP;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance under this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the City of San Diego. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded hereunder are not  
subject to local hiring freezes.
