A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING THE NOMINATION OF THE SAN DIEGO VETERANS' WAR MEMORIAL BUILDING IN BALBOA PARK TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES.

WHEREAS, the State of California Office of Historic Preservation has requested review and comment on the nomination of the San Diego Veterans' War Memorial Building in Balboa Park pursuant to the provisions of the Certified Local Government Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 111.0206 of the San Diego Municipal Code provides for City Council endorsement of National Register nominations, subject to Historic Resources Board recommendation; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego Historical Resources Board is the duly appointed board empowered to identify and preserve historical resources in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2000, the Historical Resources Board found that the San Diego Veterans' War Memorial Building in Balboa Park has significant historical value based on HRB CRITERIA A (Community history, cultural, social, economic, political, aesthetic development), CRITERIA B (Significant event), CRITERIA C (Architecture), and CRITERIA D (Master Architect); and

WHEREAS, on the same date, the Historical Resources Board further recommended that the City Council support the nomination of the San Diego Veterans' War Memorial Building to the National Register of Historic Places, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it endorses and recommends that the San Diego Veterans' War Memorial Building in Balboa Park be nominated to the National Register of Historic Places.
