

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293178

ADOPTED ON MAY 30 2000

WHEREAS, the Fourth District Senior Resource Center (FDSRC) was established in 1990 with the mission of enhancing and embracing the quality of life for Seniors residing in the Fourth Council District; and

WHEREAS, the programs' goals are to provide a wholesome and safe environment for seniors in their attempt to lead a more satisfying lifestyle, to encourage them to become more proactive in using their resources, and to help them in living more independently, thus becoming more informed through educational, recreational, and referral services; and

WHEREAS, an Executive Director, eight Office Volunteers, and ten Community Ambassadors assist in providing services and programs to community residents, including education, nutrition, tax assistance, appropriate information & referrals, peer counseling, legal assistance, computer classes, intergenerational forums, health, ethnic, and resource fairs, the Martin Luther King Jr. Senior Nutrition Program, free monthly blood pressure checks, administered by the Black Nurses Association, and the Health Insurance Advocacy Program (HICAP); and

WHEREAS, monthly chapter meetings are held at the FDSRC for the Metro American Association of Retired Persons # 4916, the Fourth District Seniors Commission, and the Fourth District Senior Caregivers' Support Group; and

WHEREAS, the FDSRC serves the communities of: Skyline Hills, Emerald Hills, Lomita Village, Jamacha, Paradise Hills, Valencia Park, Lincoln Park, Mountain View, Mt. Hope, Chollas Park, Oak Park, North & South Bay Terrace, and Encanto; and

WHEREAS, the FDSRC collaborated with Metro AARP in presenting two Breast Cancer Awareness Workshops held at the Gateway Medical Center and their Director served on a panel as a Nutrition Educator at Chollas View United Methodist Church's Breast Cancer Awareness Seminar; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends the Fourth District Senior Resource Center for their efforts to serve our "seasoned community treasures" with pride, dignity, and love.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 26, 2000 be and is hereby proclaimed to be "**Fourth District Senior Resource Center Day**" in The City of San Diego.
