## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293182

## ADOPTED ON MAY 3 0 2000

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, a municipal corporation, ("City") leases land at Montgomery Field Airport to Gibbs Flying Service, Inc., a California corporation, ("Gibbs") by a long-term lease agreement. Gibbs owns the improvements on the leasehold. By a separate lease agreement, the City leases back a helipad and two hangars from Gibbs, which are used by the City's Police Air Support Unit to operate, maintain and store its aircraft. These aircraft are used by the City's Police Department for surveillance and transportation. The lease is renewable annually at City's option until June 30, 2002, when said lease expires. The First Amendment to the City's lease from Gibbs (Document No. RR-273254) added a small hangar to the lease. The City has since acquired two additional helicopters, necessitating more hangar space to store aircraft. The new hangar space will allow the City to secure all its aircraft and protect these valuable assets from vandalism, theft, and weather. The additional hangar will also give the Police Air Support Unit better access to all of its aircraft and eliminate the need to move aircraft around before responding to emergencies, thus improving response time; and

WHEREAS, the City and Gibbs have now negotiated a Second Amendment to Lease Agreement whereby Hangar No. 201 will be added to the City's leasehold, and the City's rent will be increased from \$3,993.12 to \$4,278.12 per month. The rent will be further adjusted by CPI rent adjustment on July 1, 2000 and annually thereafter, resulting in a total annual rent not to exceed \$53,000 for FY 2001; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, a Second Amendment to Lease Agreement with Gibbs Flying Service, Inc., a California corporation, for the leasing of an additional aircraft storage hangar, a Port-A-Port hangar known as Hangar No. 201, as set forth in that lease agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-293182.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the additional expenditure for FY 2000 will be \$285, and the total expenditure for FY 2001 will be in an amount not to exceed \$53,000 from the Police Seized and Forfeited Asset Fund 10118, with annual CPI rent adjustments thereafter, is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the above described lease.
