WHEREAS, during the 1999-2000 season, the Hoover High School Lady Cardinals basketball team achieved their goal of becoming Harbor League Champions—the first girls basketball league championship in the school's 69-year history--finishing the season with a 21-7 record overall and an undefeated, 12-0 record in the Harbor League; and

WHEREAS, during the season the Hoover High School Lady Cardinals broke the school record for most victories (21) and most consecutive wins (15), and for the second consecutive season were ranked as the #1 defensive team in Division II; and

WHEREAS, during the season Lady Cardinals team member Arleasha Iverson eclipsed the 1,000-point career mark and became the all-time leading scorer in Hoover High School history, while being named to her fourth All-League team and Athlete of the Week by the San Diego Union-Tribune; and

WHEREAS, three Lady Cardinals—Summer Bradford, Ebonie Kerley, and Arleasha Iverson—were named to the First Team All-League team; and

WHEREAS, the Hoover High School Lady Cardinals accomplished this feat under first-year coach Roger DiCarlo; and

WHEREAS, the 1999-2000 Hoover High School Lady Cardinals basketball team had as its members Arleasha Iverson, Nicole Haynes, Summer Bradford, Ebonie Kerley, Antoinette McCray, Janie Hanesana, Sinnamone Knighton, and Desarae Wilfong; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby recognize the outstanding achievement of the 1999-2000 Hoover High School Lady

Cardinals basketball team for winning the school's first-ever Harbor League Championship.
