BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all of the real property in The City of San Diego included within the exterior boundary lines of the map designated as Zone 3 of the Downtown Maintenance Assessment District, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-204712, is proposed to be detached from the Downtown Maintenance Assessment District, such detachment is conditioned upon the formation of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an assessment engineer's report be prepared and

filed in accordance with the Law.
