RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293455

ADOPTED ON JUL 17 2000

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2000, LandGrant Development of San Diego, California, filed with the City Clerk's Office a ballot proposal regarding the Coastal Zone height restriction (People's Ordinance No. O-10960 (New Series)); and

WHEREAS, the ballot proposal was filed by the deadline established pursuant to Council Policy 000-21; and

WHEREAS, People's Ordinance No. 10960 (New Series) was enacted by the voters as Proposition D on November 7, 1972, limiting the height of buildings in the Coastal Zone; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.2528 requires that any initiated legislative act adopted by a majority vote of the voters may be amended or repealed only by a vote of the majority of the voters or by Charter amendment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that it directs the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance placing the ballot proposal on the ballot at a municipal election consolidated with the next general statewide election on November 7, 2000.
