That the expenditure of \$1.5 million from Refuse Disposal Enterprise Fund No. 41201, CIP 32-010.0, Annual Allocation Unclassified Disposal Site Closure for burn site assessments, remediation and cost associated with resolving burn ash site issues is hereby authorized; and that no demolition or construction activities will occur with this action provided that the Auditor's Certificate is furnished demonstrating funds for this expenditure are or will be on deposit in the City treasury.
- 4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reorganize the Environmental Services Department to create an Environmental Protection Division to enhance focus on burn site remediation and hazardous materials management issues, and add one Deputy Director position.
