A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL IMPERIAL REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DATE, TIME AND PLACE THEREFORE; AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE OF THE JOINT PUBLIC HEARING; AND ACCEPTING AND RECEIVING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION TO THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] has prepared a proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project [Project], which Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Cal. Health & Safety Code § 33000 et seq.) [Law]; and

WHEREAS, the Law requires a joint public hearing on the proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project with the consent of the Agency and the Council of the City of San Diego [Council]; and

WHEREAS, the Agency, by Resolution No. R-<u>032/3</u> [RA-2001-19], has consented to a joint public hearing on the proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project and has requested that the Council consent to the joint public hearing and establish the date, time, and place therefore; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council consents to a joint public hearing with the Agency on the proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project and authorizes the City Clerk, in cooperation with the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, to establish the date, time, and place for the joint public hearing.
- 2. That the City of San Diego shall, by its designee and in cooperation with the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, publish and mail the notice of joint public hearing on the proposed Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, in the manner, and with other documents as required and established by law.
- 3. That the Council receives and accepts the Mitigated Negative Declaration to the Third Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project.
