

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 293740

WHEREAS, Karen Manley is a 28-year resident of Mid-City who has been a tireless, dedicated and selfless community activist working to improve the quality of life for the residents of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, during the past 15 years, Karen Manley, as a resident of City Heights, has served on dozens of community boards, committees, focus groups and task forces, serving as a charter member and former chair of the City Heights Town Council, secretary of the City Heights Law Enforcement Committee, on the board of the Prostitution Task Force, Neighborhood Housing Services, Mid-City Development Corporation, Enterprise Zone Board, and the City Heights Partnership, and as a member of the Mid-City Police Station, City Heights Library, Urban Village, City Heights Town Council, and City Heights Neighborhood Service Center focus groups; and

WHEREAS, as the president of I-15 Now!, Karen Manley has been the recognized leader of the successful grassroots movement which was instrumental in bringing about the completion of Interstate 15, which runs through the heart of Mid-City; and

WHEREAS, Karen Manley currently serves as vice chair of the City Heights Town Council, and on the boards of *Mid-City Neighbor*, I-15 Oversight Committee, as a member of the Sewer Rate Advisory Committee and as the Mid-City representative on the Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations; and


WHEREAS, in addition to serving on boards and committees, Karen Manley has been a dedicated community volunteer, working with Volunteers in Policing, as media spokesperson for the City Heights Economic Crime Summit, and with the City Heights Community Garden; and

WHEREAS, because of her efforts, Karen Manley has received the Commanding Officer's Citation from the San Diego Police Department, a 1997 District Three Community Spirit Award, and a Certificate of Appreciation from the Fourth District of the County of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the outstanding contributions of KAREN MANLEY to improve the quality of life for the citizens of San Diego through her volunteer and community service efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that September 12, 2000, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "**KAREN MANLEY DAY**" in the City of San Diego.
