Diego 2000 - Where the Future Begins; and


WHEREAS, San Diego Goes Back to School Day will give parents and community

Family School Partnership Act requires them to give parents up to 8 hours per month off to
participate in school events with their children, either with pay, as compensatory time off or
without pay; and

San Diego Education Association, California School Employees Association, Administrators
Association San Diego, San Diego City Schools Peace Officers Association, San Diego Unified
