That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under the contract are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury.
- 4. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$6,451,981 is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds for this project, to be expended as follows: \$6,192,352 from Sewer Fund No. 41508, CIP 45-941.0, South Metro Downtown Tunnel Rehabilitation, for project construction and related costs, including \$50,000 for use of City Forces and \$20,000 for the City of Coronado for special controlled operation of its Transbay Pump Station; and \$259,629 from Fund No. 41508, CIP 46-501.0, Annual Allocation Metro Pooled Contingency.

for project contingency; provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under the contract are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury.

5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves on advice of the administering department.
