A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MID-CITY COMMUNITIES PLAN AND PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN TO REDESIGNATE 4.88 ACRES FROM COMMERCIAL RESIDENTIAL MIXED-USE TO MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego adopted the Progress Guide and General Plan on February 26, 1979, and adopted the updated Mid-City Communities Plan on August 4, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-City Communities Plan designates the subject properties for a mix of residential and commercial use; and

WHEREAS, the Council, on September 12, 2000, initiated a study of the redesignation of the properties located north of Orange Avenue between 41<sup>st</sup> Street and Marlborough Avenue (2.87 acres), and properties located between 250 feet and 300 feet north of University Avenue between 44<sup>th</sup> Street and 47<sup>th</sup> Street (2.01 acres), from commercial and residential mixed-use to multi-family residential use; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments have been found consistent with the objective, identified in the Mid-City Communities Plan, of preserving established and stable residential neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered all maps, exhibits and written documents contained in the file for this proposal on record in the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that on OCT 24 2000, the Council hereby approves the proposed amendments to the Mid-City Communities Plan and Progress Guide and General Plan to redesignate the land use in the above-described areas.
