A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COUNCIL POLICY NO. 900-16
REGARDING CONSERVATION OF ENERGY.

WHEREAS, local governments are not only large consumers of energy, but as permitting agencies, they are in a unique position to positively influence building practices to encourage significant reduction in energy consumption; and


WHEREAS, building design and construction decisions create long-term impacts, both financial and environmental, which present the City of San Diego citizens with an opportunity to reduce energy expenditures, enhance the quality of our buildings, and improve the environmental while strengthening the regional economy; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has recognized the potential damaging effects of changing energy markets and supports comprehensive voluntary energy-efficiency standards, for new commercial and multi-family residential construction projects, which will reduce electricity demand, save taxpayers money and improve the environment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Council Policy No. 900-16, which provides incentives and encourages energy-efficient practices in the building industry, be and is established as set forth in the Council Policy filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 294070.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is instructed to add the aforesaid to
the Council Policy Manual.
