

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 294159

ADOPTED ON NOV 14 2000

WHEREAS, Christ's New Creation Community Church was founded in November 1995 by Rev. Donna Eubanks, Rev. Jim Dennison and 33 congregation members with the mission to establish a church which provides an inclusive worship space where all are welcome, regardless of age, race, social and economic standing, or sexual orientation; and

WHEREAS, during the past five years the congregation of Christ's New Creation Community Church has grown to 125 members, and has purchased a permanent home for the church at the corner of Thorn Street and First Avenue in Bankers Hill; and

WHEREAS, in addition to serving the needs of the congregation, the staff and members at Christ's New Creation Community Church are actively involved in the Uptown Interfaith Shelter Network and numerous other community outreach programs, which include the free annual Christ's New Creation Community Church Christmas Concert held in conjunction with the San Diego Men's Chorus at University Christian Church, free musical concerts by the church's musical group "Reveille," which are held throughout the community and throughout the year, and financial donations to Auntie Helen's Fluff 'n' Fold; and

WHEREAS, the congregation of Christ's New Creation Community Church also participates in and lends a large presence to community events which include AIDS Walk San Diego, San Diego Lesbian and Gay Pride, the San Diego Breast Cancer Walk, and the Gay/Lesbian Rodeo Association event; and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2000, the congregation of Christ's New Creation Community Church will commemorate its fifth anniversary at a special celebration at the church;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby recognize the efforts of Christ's New Creation Community Church over the past five years to provide a spiritual home and center for all San Diegans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that November 12, 2000, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "CHRIST'S NEW CREATION COMMUNITY CHURCH DAY" in the City of San Diego.
