## ADOPTED ON NOV 2 0 2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO IDENTIFYING THE CENSUS TRACTS COMPRISING "TARGETED EMPLOYMENT AREAS" FOR THE SAN YSIDRO/OTAY MESA ENTERPRISE ZONE AND THE METROPOLITAN ENTERPRISE ZONE.

WHEREAS, two enterprise zones were established in the City of San Diego pursuant to the Enterprise Zone Act (Government Code sections 7070 et seq.), as adopted by the State of California in 1984; and

WHEREAS, in 1996 by Senate Bill No. 2023, the State of California revised the Enterprise Zone Act to provide commencing on January 1, 1997, among other things, for the establishment of "targeted employment areas" composed of census tracts having at least fifty-one percent (51%) of its residents at low or moderate income levels, with the purpose of encouraging businesses in an enterprise zone to hire eligible residents of those geographic areas of the city most in need of employment targeting; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Act as thus revised allows the City Council of the City of San Diego to designate those census tracts identified with the most need of this employment targeting; and

WHEREAS, the San Ysidro/Otay Mesa Enterprise Zone is expanded to include properties within the City of Chula Vista and the state legislation allows for the expansion of TEA's to remain consist with Enterprise Zone boundaries; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the census tracts as listed on Attachment 5, which are lying within and/or contiguous to the established enterprises zones of the City of San Diego, have been designated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development as having at least fifty-one percent (51%) of their residents of low and moderate income levels, and are hereby identified as those census tracts which are in the most need of employment targeting pursuant to the Enterprise Zone Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a targeted employment area composed of the above specified census tracts and having the boundaries created by grouping the said census tracts together, as shown in Attachment 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.


