	WHEREAS, notice of	f such hearing has	s been given by	y the City Manager t	to all affected

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard, NOW, THEREFORE,

and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the public health, safety, or general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to establish the date by which the property in the District must be ready to receive underground service, and the date when all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures are to be removed and replaced by the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen days after date of adoption. The City Manager shall further notify affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all the necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations, and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of the adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances.

- 4. The City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish Fund No. 78164 for the purpose of depositing Public Utilities Commission Case 8209 Utility Underground Allocation Funds.
- 5. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to receive these funds from San Diego Gas & Electric Company.
- 6. Reimbursement payments to all qualified property owners in the 25th Street (from Market Street to Commercial Street) Underground Utility District is hereby authorized as reimbursement for the electrical service underground conversion work done on private property, to be reimbursed from Case 8209 Funds deposited by SDG&E with the City Treasurer for this purpose.
- 7. The City Treasurer is authorized to return to SDG&E undisbursed funds, if any, on written notice from SDG&E to the City that all electrical service conversions in the 25th Street (from Market Street to Commercial Street) Underground Utility District have been completed.
- 8. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,000 from Annual Allocation -Undergrounding of City Utilities, CIP 37-028.0, TransNet Fund No. 30300, is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds to administer the District, pay for minor City Force work, replace existing street lights, and other related work.

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION FOR THE 25th STREET FROM MARKET STREET TO COMMERCIAL STREET UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT

The 25TH STREET FROM MARKET STREET TO COMMERCIAL STREET UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT shall be established to include the following described parcels:

Portion Lots 1 thru 3 and Portion Lots 46 thru 48 of BLOCK 9, Portion Lots 1 thru 3 and Portion Lots 45 thru 48 of BLOCK 10, Lots 1 thru 4 and Portion Lots 45 thru 48 of BLOCK 11, Lots 23 thru 24 and Portion Lots 29 thru 30 of BLOCK 21, Lots 27 and 28 of BLOCK 20 of MAP OF L.W. KIMBALL'S SUBDIVISION, Map No. 56;

Portion Lots 1 thru 4, Lots 47 thru 48, Portion Lots 45 and 46 of BLOCK 12, Portion Lots 20 thru 26, Portion Lots 29 thru 30 of BLOCK 19, Lots 1 thru 4 of BLOCK 13, Portion Lots 19 thru 20, Lots 21 thru 22 of BLOCK 18 of MAP OF LINCOLN PARK FORMERLY KNOWN AS FRARY'S ADDITION, Map No. 478.

K STREET a line parallel to and \pm 100 feet west of the westerly line of 25TH STREET.


ISLAND AVENUE a line parallel to and ± 140 feet east of the easterly line of 25TH STREET.




