

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 294290

ADOPTED ON NOV 27 2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A REPRESENTATIVE PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR THE COLLEGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego [the Council] by Resolution No. R-280718, adopted the Procedure of the Formation of a Project Area Committee [PAC] for the College Community Redevelopment Project at its September 22, 1992 meeting; and

WHEREAS, an election was conducted on October 3, 2000, after notice and according to established procedures enumerated within the documents approved by the City Council and a representative from the City Clerk's Office attended the election to ensure its validity; and

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law [Law] requires that PAC remain in existence for three years from the date of adoption of the redevelopment plan; and

WHEREAS, the elected members of the Project Area Committee have submitted to this City Council information establishing the qualifications of each person relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


1. That the College Community Redevelopment Project Area Committee consisting of persons named on the list of Project Area Committee members receiving the highest number of votes, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved as constituting a representative Project Area Committee.

2. That the Council hereby concurs that the election results are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No. R-280718.

3. That the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego is hereby directed to consult with and obtain the advice of the Project Area Committee concerning those policy matters which deal with the planning and provision of residential facilities or replacement housing and other matters which affect the residents of the Project Area for a period of three years after adoption of the Redevelopment Plan or until the PAC is no longer in existence.

4. That the City Council hereby extends the effective life of the PAC through the next Annual Election of the PAC in calendar year 2001.


