

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 294303

ADOPTED ON NOV 27 2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CERTIFYING THAT THE COUNCIL HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287, DATED JANUARY 1997 RELATED TO APPROVAL OF THE MSCP PROGRAM AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS OF APPROVING A THREE YEAR MSCP FUNDING POLICY STATEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has previously prepared, and the City Council (Resolution No. R-288457) has certified an EIR/EIS for the approval of the Multiple Species Conservation Program (referred to herein as the "MSCP"); and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to approve a three year funding policy statement as required by Section 11.2C.3 of the City's MSCP Implementing Agreement for the purpose of establishing and implementing a funding source adequate to meet the City's share of MSCP and Subarea Plan implementation costs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the environmental effects of the proposed three year funding policy statement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council certifies that the information contained in EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287 has been reviewed and considered by the City Council members; and

2. The City Council finds and determines that:

a. No substantial changes are proposed in the MSCP Program with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken which will require important revisions in the previously certified EIR/EIS for the Project, due to the involvement of new significant environmental impacts not covered in the EIR/EIS; and


b. No new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which was not known or could not have been known at the time EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287 for the Project was certified as complete, and which shows that the Project will have any significant effects not discussed previously in the EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287 or that any significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287, or that any mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible or not previously considered would substantially reduce or lessen any significant effects of the Project on the environment; and

c. No negative declaration, or subsequent environmental impact report, or supplement or addendum to EIR/EIS, LDR File No. 93-0287 is necessary or required; and

d. Approval of the three year MSCP policy statement will have no significant effect on the environment, except as identified and considered in the MEIR for the Project.
