APPROVING A RESOLUTION LIMITING THE FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF AIRPORT SITES TO NORTH ISLAND, MIRAMAR EAST AND CAMP PENDLETON AND CALLING FOR BINATIONAL COOPERATION REGARDING PLANNING FOR THE CROSS BORDER AIR TERMINAL AND CALLING UPON THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT TO PROCEED TO COMPLETE THE SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT MASTER PLAN AND TO IMMEDIATELY ANALYZE ALL ALTERNATIVES THOROUGHLY.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2000, the Council of the City of San Diego held a workshop to discuss regional airport capacity needs and alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council considered information on several potentially viable airport sites to serve as a replacement of or companion to Lindbergh Field (San Diego International Airport); and

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council discussed the importance of proceeding as quickly as possible with an update to the Master Plan for Lindbergh Field (San Diego International Airport) which is a key element of an overall regional airport strategy for the San Diego region; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council has considered all maps, exhibits and written documents contained in the file for this issue on record in the City of San Diego, and has considered the oral discussions held during the public workshop; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the future consideration of airport sites to resolve the region's capacity needs shall be limited to North Island, Miramar East, and Camp Pendleton; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to work with SANDAG to request that the Joint Airports Advisory Committee include these three sites in any regional strategy to be considered; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to return to the City Council after the January 2001 Joint Airports Advisory Committee meeting with a work program and fiscal impact for studying the feasibility of the three airport sites; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if and when Mexican authorities expand the Tijuana International Airport, the City of San Diego stands ready to work closely with our Mexican counterparts to ensure that such an expansion benefits citizens on both sides of the international border; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego encourages the Mexican authorities to work closely with the City of San Diego towards the goal of developing a Cross Border Air Terminal; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Otay Mesa Community should be allowed to participate in the planning process on the American side of the border for any future Cross Border Air Terminal project and this project should be added to the work plan for the Binational Planning and Coordinating Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego calls upon the San Diego
Unified Port District to proceed to complete the San Diego International Airport Master Plan and
to immediately analyze all alternatives thoroughly
