BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City is authorized to provide the required matching resources, if any, and ongoing costs of operation relating to this program, including any amendments thereof, under the program and funding terms and conditions of the State of

California;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that expenditures and personnel positions funded hereunder are not subject to local spending or hiring freezes.
