

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 18960 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JUL 9 2001

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS
MOTIVE EQUIPMENT TO THE CITY OF TIJUANA.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department usually dispose of surplus equipment by auction, pursuant to Section 35 of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Charter also allows the City Council to authorize the disposal of surplus equipment directly to another agency; and

WHEREAS, prior to the auction of May 11-12, 2001, the City of Tijuana inspected the available surplus equipment and identified desired equipment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 35 of the City Charter, the sale of the following surplus motive equipment to the City of Tijuana is hereby authorized:



Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
