

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19000 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON NOV 5 2001

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A DISTRICT
PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO, ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2002.

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the San Diego City Charter provides that commencing with the year 1998 the Municipal Primary Elections to the office of Councilmember for Districts 2, 4, 6, and 8 shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State Primary Election, and the General Municipal Election for these offices shall be on the same date as the California State General Election for that year; and

WHEREAS, under Section 27.0103 of the San Diego Municipal Code a District Primary Election is one form of Municipal Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on NOV 5 2001, the City Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution Number R- 295694, requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego to order the consolidation of the District Primary Election to be held on March 5, 2002, with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a District Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, March 5, 2002, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 2	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 4	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 6	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 8	four-year term

Section 2. It is hereby ordered that, in the event one candidate receives a majority of votes cast for all candidates for nomination to a particular Council District seat, the candidate receiving the majority of votes shall be deemed to be and declared by the Council to be elected to such office, all in accordance with Charter section 10.

Section 3. For the purpose of said elections, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list on consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.


Section 4. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 5, 2002.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of the City of San Diego.

Section 6. A full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 7. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
