1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$5,000 from Development Impact Fees (DIF) Fund 79513 to CIP 62-002.0 "Minor Signal Requirements."

2. That the FY 2001 CIP Budget is hereby increased to reflect the increased appropriation of \$5,000 into CIP 62-002.0.

3. That the expenditure of \$5,000 from CIP 62-002.0 "Minor Signal Requirements" to expedite the traffic signal modification at Fourth Avenue at E Street in Centre City to add pedestrian indications for the purpose of establishing a "pedestrian scramble" phase is hereby authorized.
