A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FOR A DEFERRED LOAN FOR CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT THROUGH THEIR EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development, Division of Community Affairs, issued a Notice of Funding Availability [NOFA] for the Emergency Housing Assistance Program [EHAP] (Capital Development Deferred Loans); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a local government agency which is eligible and wishes to apply for and receive EHAP funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager, or designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, to apply for an EHAP loan in an amount not more than the maximum amount permitted by the NOFA, and in accordance with the program statute, regulations, and local Emergency Shelter Strategy, where applicable.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager or his designee agrees to use the EHAP funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by the department and in accordance with the California Health and Safety Code sections 50800-50806.5; title 25, sections 7950-76 of the California Code of Regulations; Cal. Stats. 2000, ch.

52; and, the Standard Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the Standard Agreement, and all documents, including applications, contracts, agreements, and all subsequent amendments with the department necessary to implement and carry out the purpose of this funding provided that the Auditor first issue a certificate certifying that funds are available in the City Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to accept and expend funds from the Department of Housing and Community Development, Division of Community Affairs and Emergency Housing and Assistance Program (Capital Development Deferred Loans), to implement and carry out the purpose of this funding provided that the Auditor first issue a certificate certifying that funds are available in the City Treasury.
