A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FOX HOLLOW APARTMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission of the City of San Diego has recommended that the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego [the Authority] issue multifamily housing revenue bonds [the Bonds] to finance the acquisition and construction of a multifamily rental housing project in the City of San Diego described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto [the Project]; and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representatives after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on March 2, 2001; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by this City Council on March 20, 2001, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That City Council finds and declares that the above recitals are true and correct.

- 2. That the City Council, as the applicable elected representatives under Section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority in a principal amount not to exceed \$7,000,000 to finance the acquisition and construction of the Project.
- 3. The City Council confirms that it is appropriate for the Authority to issue the Bonds to finance the construction of the Project. Prior to the issuance of the Bonds, the role of the nonprofit entity that will be a partner of the owner of the Project shall be reviewed and approved by the Housing Commission.
 - 4. This resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.
