WHEREAS, Ms. Phyllis Marrow, has faithfully served the City of San Diego as an employee with distinction since June 2, 1980; and

WHEREAS, she has served for the past 21 years as a Sanitation Driver and an Area Refuse Collection Supervisor in the Collection Services Division; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Marrow has played a key role in the recent innovations in residential refuse and recycling collection, including training many of the automated drivers, who now serve the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, her work performance exemplifies the quality of work performed by Collection Services Division employees and staff who have consistently been "top rated" in Customer Satisfaction and among the lowest in overall cost; and

WHEREAS, Ms Marrow has earned the respect and admiration of her subordinates, peers and superiors, as well as the residents of the City of San Diego that she has served so loyally, and

WHEREAS, she exhibits the virtues taught by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. through his personal conduct and in the performance of her duties; and

WHEREAS, in late March 1968, Dr Martin Luther King, Jr. arrived in Memphis, Tennessee to lead sanitation workers in a march on City Hall to protest low wages and poor working conditions and was assassinated on April 4, 1968; and

WHEREAS, April 4 is recognized nationally by various cities as an opportunity to honor Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr 's efforts to improve the plight of sanitation workers; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends Ms Phyllis Marrow for her service and dedication to the City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that April 2, 2001 be and is hereby proclaimed to be **"MS. PHYLLIS MARROW DAY"** in the City of San Diego in honor of her receipt of the Second Annual City of San Diego Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Sanitation Worker Award.
