WHEREAS, in 1970, he received his Ph.D. in Human Behavior/Psychology from the U.S International University (USIU) in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, he worked as a Elementary and Middle School Teacher, Master Demonstration Teacher, School Psychologist/Social Worker, and Community Relations Coordinator for the San Diego Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, Dr. del Campo served as Dean of Student Affairs at San Diego City College from 1971-1974 and President of the Continuing Education Centers for the San Diego Community College District from 1974-1985; and

WHEREAS, in 1985, he became Dean of the School of Education at USIU and in 1987 became Dean of Extended Services and University Affairs at USIU, and

WHEREAS, for the past fourteen years Dr del Campo has been a professional consultant who has been assisting with Community College grant proposals at Deloitte, Haskins, and Sells and developing affirmative action programs for the San Diego Community College District, and

WHEREAS, he has provided much service to the City of San Diego as a member of numerous organizations, including the Community College Board of Governors, City of San Diego Stadium Advisory Board, Richard J. Donovan Correctional Institution Advisory Board,

California State Commission on Juvenile Justice, Crime, and Delinquency Programs, Alvarado Hospital Board of Governors, and the Natural History Museum Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Dr. del Campo is currently serving on the Board of Governors for the Boys and Girls Aid Foundation and the Board of Directors of the San Diego City/County Historical Society; NOW, THEREFORE,
