

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 294778

ADOPTED ON APR 17 2001

WHEREAS, the Otay Valley Regional Park Concept Plan [the Concept Plan] was prepared by staff from the County of San Diego and the Cities of San Diego and Chula Vista to provide a conceptual framework for development of a linear regional park focused on the Otay River Valley from San Diego Bay inland to Lower Otay Lake, and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the Concept Plan was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the Council of the City of San Diego, and

WHEREAS, the Concept Plan was heard by the Council on APR 17 2001, and

WHEREAS, program level environmental review of the Concept Plan has been accomplished through the City of San Diego's Multiple Species Conservation Program Plan's Final Environmental Impact Report [Final EIR] LDR No 93-0287, certified by the City Council by Resolution No R-288457, on March 18, 1997, a copy of the Final EIR LDR No 93-0287 is on file in the Development Services Department, and


