WHEREAS, Jack Winer has been a dedicated volunteer for the San Diego Public Library system for many years and currently serves as the President of the San Diego Friends of the Library; and

WHEREAS, under Jack Winer's leadership, the Friends of the Library will give nearly \$300,000 to the Matching Book and Equipment Fund this year; and

WHEREAS, his motto for the organization is F.A.M.E. - Fund-raising, Advocacy, Membership and Education; and

WHEREAS, Jack Winer is gifted in mobilizing large groups and bringing them together to achieve a common goal; and

WHEREAS, he has helped build a coalition consisting of the Friends of the San Diego Public Library, the San Diego Public Library, the San Diego Unified School District, citizens, parents and corporate sponsors; and

WHEREAS, this contest has become an ongoing project under the direction of the Friends of the San Diego Public Library and has grown in both the number of participating schools and the number of entrants with 1,200 students participating last year; and

WHEREAS, Jack Winer will end his term as the President of the Friends in August of this year after making countless contributions to the citizens of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the many accomplishments and dedication of Jack Winer, and hereby proclaims June 4, 2001 to be "**Jack J. Winer Day**" in the City of San Diego.
